




A Momentous Milestone in California Republican History... “As we approach Thanksgiving and the holiday season, I am filled with awe, humility and deep gratitude to think about everything we’ve accomplished in the past few months – all thanks to the tireless efforts and dogged determination of a group of amazing Republican women, and encouragement from many other ardent supporters,” Golden State Republican Women (GSRW) President Janet Price said recently as she announced that on Oct. 1, 2023 the alliance was officially chartered by the California Republican Party (CAGOP).

“This momentous occasion is nothing short of a miracle that represents a huge victory for all California Republican women,” she added.

A Grand Victory for All... “We did it!” exclaimed Golden State Republican Women (GSRW) President Janet Price as she announced that the alliance’s charter had been approved by the California Republican party during the recent CAGOP Fall 2023 Convention in Anaheim California.



The “AYEs” have it!... A floor vote on Oct. 1 at the CAGOP Fall 2023 Convention resulted in adoption of GSRW’s charter by a resounding 67.2% “in favor” vote.

- Early 2023, 47 like-minded women from across California decide it’s time for a change for the better and begin formulating plans for a new, vibrant, statewide Republican women’s alliance that not only reflects our common conservative views and values, but also embraces our diversity.
- Spring 2023, the founding planning team meets often via Zoom; they name the alliance “Golden State Republican Women” (GSRW).
- Summer 2023, GSRW convenes its first in-person planning meeting to begin laying the alliance’s foundational tracks.
- Oct. 1, at the CAGOP Fall 2023 Convention, GSRW’s charter is overwhelmingly approved.

California's 2024 Primary Election is five months away, and we must do everything we can to get the right candidates elected to office – and protect our votes.

Every four years, laws quietly change to favor the left. It hasn't been accidental, nor has it been fair. Changing OUR way of thinking may be our only defense against a total Democrat monopolized legislature.

Whether it's ballot harvesting, voting by mail or extended voting, Republicans must start thinking differently to counter each attack on fair elections that diminishes our vote. Early voting has been problematic for Republicans. Democrats know Republicans are resistant to changing from the better, safer system of one-day voting, showing ID and hearing the results on election night – which long has fostered a sense of comfort and pride in fair American elections.

Just as we learned to collect our friends' and neighbors' ballots, we can re-think early voting. Here are a few reasons to vote early:

1. You will be the first and only person who can use your ballot. If you have provided a current email address, a few days after dropping off or mailing your ballot, you should be notified that your vote has been *received and counted*. Now, no one else can vote with your name.
2. Early voting allows time for you to correct your ballot (e.g., you forget to sign it) so that voter registration offices can qualify it.
3. You avoid potential hassles, last-minute issues, obstacles and problems that could keep your vote from being counted (long lines, power outages or machine issues at your polling place, or illness, to name a few).

Plus it's a great feeling to know you've voted.

Lastly, remember... (1) using well-lit, well-protected drop boxes is a must, or if necessary, the U.S. Postal Service is better than not voting. Hand-delivering your ballot to your county's Registrar's office works like a charm. (2) As soon as your ballot is received, voting has begun. Happy Voting!


