They laughed and asked me to leave.




Meet & Greet!


GSRW Facebook Posts Go Viral!

BREAKING: Jan 6 Committee Nominated For Oscar For Best Film Editing







Barbara Hallmeyer, Director of GSRW District 4, has been named State District Director.


"It's my privilege to lead this group of strong, smart, creative women who are your District Directors," Barbara said. Her job is new, and here's what she does:

New Deadline for 'Protect Kids of California' Act!


The initial deadline passed, but there's a **new one** — **May 15, 2024**. This gives Californians another opportunity to place an important ballot initiative directly into the hands of voters in 2025 — the "**Protect Kids of California Act.**"

Ensure parental rights

It's time to rally, to unite grassroots movements, organizations, and houses of worship in a shared mission. Together, we can gather the signatures needed to ensure **Parental Rights** in California.

DID YOU KNOW?

Out of the 50 states, 43 do not outright forbid non-citizens from voting in state and local elections!



Have you signed?

Have you signed the petition?

The measure requires 546,000 signatures to qualify for the 2025 ballot! We need even more than that, because county clerks disqualify signatures for a variety of reasons.

What does it DO?

This Initiative will: Repeal the California law that permits male students to compete in female sports and use female locker rooms and bathrooms. It will prohibit schools from deceiving parents about their child's gender identity crisis. It will keep school officials from secretly transitioning a child, It will stop sex change operations and chemical castration on minors.

If you belong to a local organization or house of worship, ask permission to set up a table to gather signatures.

Be bold in sharing: This is a unifying, non-partisan, nonsectarian issue!



Don't Be Fooled by the Secretary of State's <u>TITLE</u>:

When you see the initiative petition for "**Protect Kids of California,"** don't be fooled by the title at the top, which reads: "**RESTRICTS RIGHTS OF TRANSGENDER YOUTH.**"

This is what Sacramento bureaucrats DO — mislabel ballot measures, purposefully, to guilt and confuse voters.

When this initiative passes, it will

- REQUIRE parental notification from schools
- PROTECT girls sports
- **PREVENT** child sterilization
